## \*Unattended Child Policy

- Library policy requires all children 7 and under to always be accompanied by a responsible caregiver. When a student of this age attends Ready Readers, their caregiver must remain in the library.
- Children ages 8 and over may be in the library unaccompanied. It is the caregiver's responsibility to communicate instructions for meeting their student at the conclusion of tutoring or programming.
