The learning intention lets the student know what they will be learning that day and the success criteria lets them know how they will know when they have learned it. The success criteria is a progression of skills that leads to the mastery of the content.

What can you do to help your student become an assessment capable and reflective learner? You can ask your student what did they learn today (the learning intentions) and how do they know if you have learned it (success criteria)? These two questions are a great starting point to find out what is happening at LMS.




#### **LMS Robotics Club**

#### The Basics To Know:

- 1. To be eligible for a club, your student has an entire grading period. The next grading period is when they receive their incentives.
- 2. Their eligibility for a club starts over every new quarter.
- 3. Fourth quarter data will still earn your student a Club Level but instead of receiving the predetermined incentives, they will be entered in drawings for the end of the year incentives. (Due to not seeing them in the summer.)


