During the week of August 26 through September 13, your child will take the MAP[®] Reading Fluency[™] screener from NWEA[®] on a computer or tablet. MAP Reading Fluency measures beginning reader skills, like letter and word knowledge, and it measures oral reading for children who are ready. We use these results to better understand your child's individual needs and to help them progress as readers.

MAP Reading Fluency screeners are unique in that they adapt to your child's skill level. If your child demonstrates readiness, they move to more challenging sections of the test. If they struggle with one section, the next questions will be easier. MAP Reading Fluency takes about 20 minutes, features an encouraging, friendly character, and is age-appropriate for young students.

Since MAP Reading Fluency provides immediate and accurate information about your child's reading, it's easy for teachers to identify students with similar scores who are generally ready for instruction in similar skills and topics and then plan instruction accordingly.
