Licensed Child Care Family Mailboxes

Each family enrolled in licensed child care has a family mailbox outside the Early Childhood Center Office. Any paper handouts from the Early Childhood Center Office will be placed there for families to pick up. Please remember to check your mailbox each time you come in the building and return any forms in a timely manner. Your family mailbox is for outgoing items ONLY.

Document Dropbox

Items that need to be returned should either be given to your child's teacher to bring to the Office, or can be placed in the blue document dropbox (pictured at right) outside Ms. Marie's window by the Early Childhood Center Office. The document dropbox (pictured at right) is always locked. Only Ms. Sarah and Ms. Marie from the Early Childhood Center Office have keys to unlock it.



Door Reminders

If your family did not yet request any door cards or fobs to use, please talk to either Ms. Sarah or Ms. Marie in the Early Childhood Center Office. Door cards or fobs are assigned upon request to parents, they are not automatically assigned. NCECC: St. Michael policy allows for a maximum of two (2) items to be assigned to a family to use.

If your family has door cards / fobs, or if you choose to be buzzed in every time you want to enter the building, please wiat until you see a green light **AND** you hear the sound of the door unlatching before you try to open the door.

Licensed Child Care Tuition

- Families Returning to Licensed Child Care Your annual registration fee and weekly charges through the end of September 2024 have been added to accounts.
- Families New to Licensed Child Care Your annual registration fee and weekly tuition charges through the end of September were added to accounts after your first day of attendance. Since your account is being newly set up, please be patient as there are many steps behind the scenes to make your account active.

Licensed Child Care Blankets During the Nap / Rest Period

All licensed child care families are required to bring a blanket for your child's rest time. Blankets should be child-sized because there is not adequate spacing in your child's cubby for a large one. We also ask that all blankets are taken home **every** Friday to be laundered.

- 2) Complete the "Diocese of La Crosse Authorization and Acknowledgement of Criminal Background Check & Authorization for Release of FBI Information" form (Link to website PDF).
 - ** Under "CATHOLIC SCHOOLS", select "Other" and answer "Classroom Volunteer" or Field Trip Chaperone".
 - ** All blanks must be completed or the background check will not be run, therefore preventing you from volunteering.
