Orono Middle School Improvements

We are so excited to welcome our students and families to OMS where they will be greeted with a newly renovated/

refreshed main office, health office, and performing arts spaces. These improvements reflect our commitment to secure and welcoming entrances and optimal learning environments for our students. The band room has new carpet and acoustic tiles; the performing arts and vocal rooms are where the office used to be! This is a years-long process with most of the physical work taking place over a few short weeks this summer. With such a tight timeline, we anticipate finishing touches to continue throughout the fall. Summer Technology Implementation

Thank you so much to our community for funding the technology levy two years ago. As a reminder, we identified three technology areas of need at that time: safety, infrastructure, and classroom learning. Over the last two years, we upgraded our 911 safety/calling system and replaced the entire wireless infrastructure on campus. This summer we enhanced all of our classroom learning spaces for the benefit of students and staff. Thank you to Sean Beaverson, Orono's Director of Technology, his staff, and our summer Tech Buddy interns who worked tirelessly to ensure we started this school year with reliable, digital learning spaces that are future-ready for our students. The district's audio/visual refresh this summer included replacement of 15-year-old Smart Boards with new, reliable "plug-and-play" technology monitors. In all, 156 classrooms were updated across five school sites.

Road Construction/Access Update

Thank you for your patience as you have navigated the road construction around campus since June. You can visit the [Hennepin County Transportation website for this project](#) at any time to view updates and changes. As we return to school, please note the following:

- County Road 6 will continue to be a detour route through this fall. As a result of increased traffic during construction, the County has installed an **interim all-way stop** at the intersection of Cty 6 and Old Crystal Bay Road. A school speed zone has also been set in this area with a **reduced speed limit of 45 mph**.
- Willow to Hwy 12 will be open fully to westbound traffic. Old Crystal Bay to our turn into the back side of campus will be open east and west bound. There will be no eastbound traffic between Hwy 12 and our turn into the back side of campus. There is also no eastbound traffic between Willow and Old Crystal Bay.

Please plan for delays as we navigate road construction through the fall. Please allow extra time if you plan to drop off or pick up your child on school days. **Thank you for driving carefully and helping us put safety first!**

Orono Community Education Summer Update

Once again this summer, our main campus and the Discovery Center were a hive of student activity! Orono Community Education reports more than **6,700 registrations** for summer classes, and this doesn't include our Spartan Kids and Discovery Kids child care programs. Wow! Thank you to our full-time staff members for their tireless work and innovative programming and our summer staff (with many Orono alumni!) who made each day fun and engaging for our kids.
