



## ITE San Diego Section Application for Student Scholarship 2024 - 2025 School Year

For 2024, ITE San Diego Section will be awarding the following four (4) scholarships to successful applicants that are pursuing a career in transportation engineering.

- One \$1,000.00 award granted to a graduate student
- Two \$1,000.00 awards granted to an undergraduate student or local community college student.
- One \$1,000.00 award granted to a high school senior residing in an equity focused community (based on zip code) or currently involved with an equity focused community-based organization.

### The minimum criteria for selection are as follows:

- GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Community college, undergraduate and graduate students – must be enrolled in a transportation-related program at time of application submission
- Graduating high school seniors – must be planning to enroll in a transportation-related program at a college or university for the Fall 2024 semester
- Graduating high school seniors – equity focused community zip codes are 91910, 91932, 91950, 91962, 92021, 92025, 92040, 92101, 92102, 92105, 92113, 92115, and 92154.
- Plans to pursue a career in a transportation-related field
- Not a previous recipient of the ITE San Diego Section scholarship under the same category

The scholarship is competitive and based on the applicant's specific transportation goals, academic record, economic background, and transportation-related activities or job skills. If you are selected, your email address may be shared with corporate sponsors for future job opportunities. Additionally, ITE San Diego may contact you to use your name and photo for advertising.
