Counselors

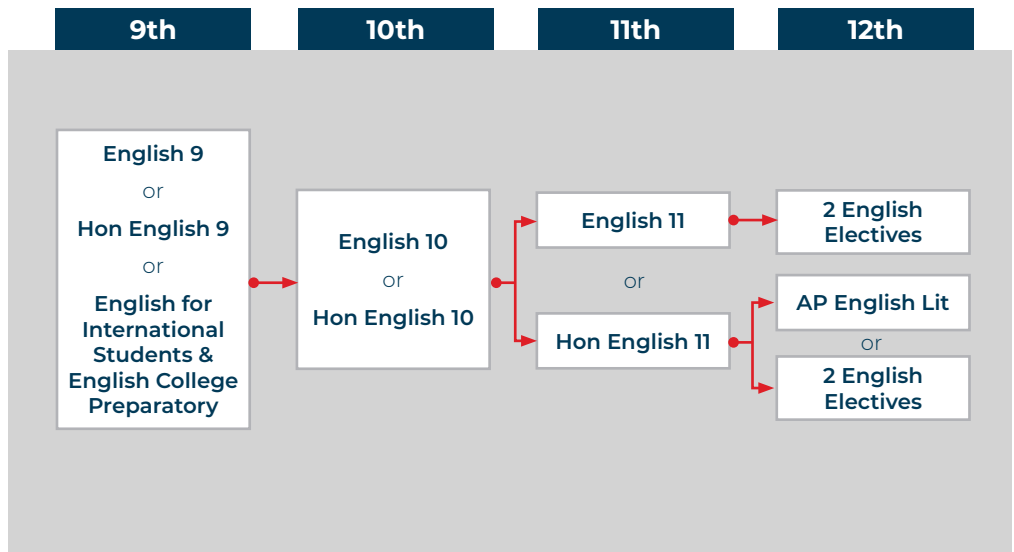
All students are assigned a counselor and will have the opportunity to discuss our course offerings and their schedule. Students will have the same counselor for all four years at Moreau Catholic.

Honors Summer Jumper Programs

Honors Algebra 2: Students enrolled in Honors Geometry have the option to take Honors Algebra 2 over the summer. This is an accelerated 6-week program that covers a year-long Honors Algebra 2 course.

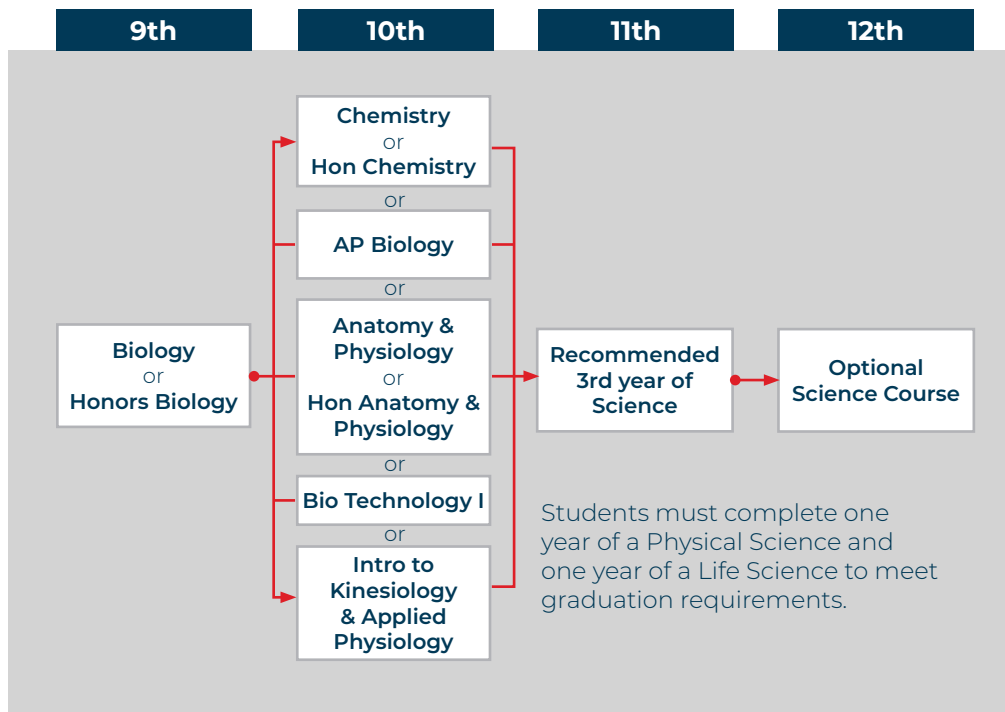

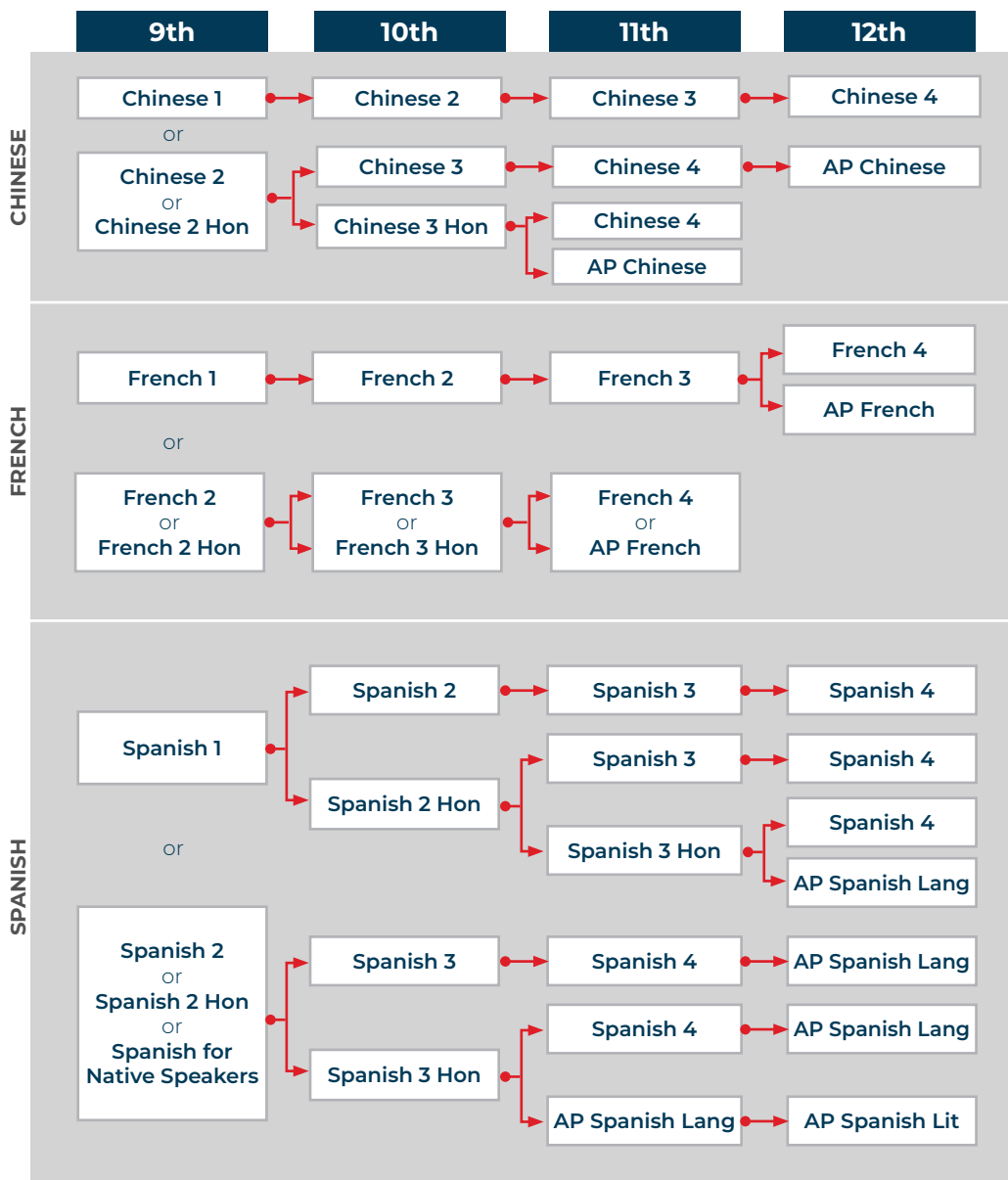

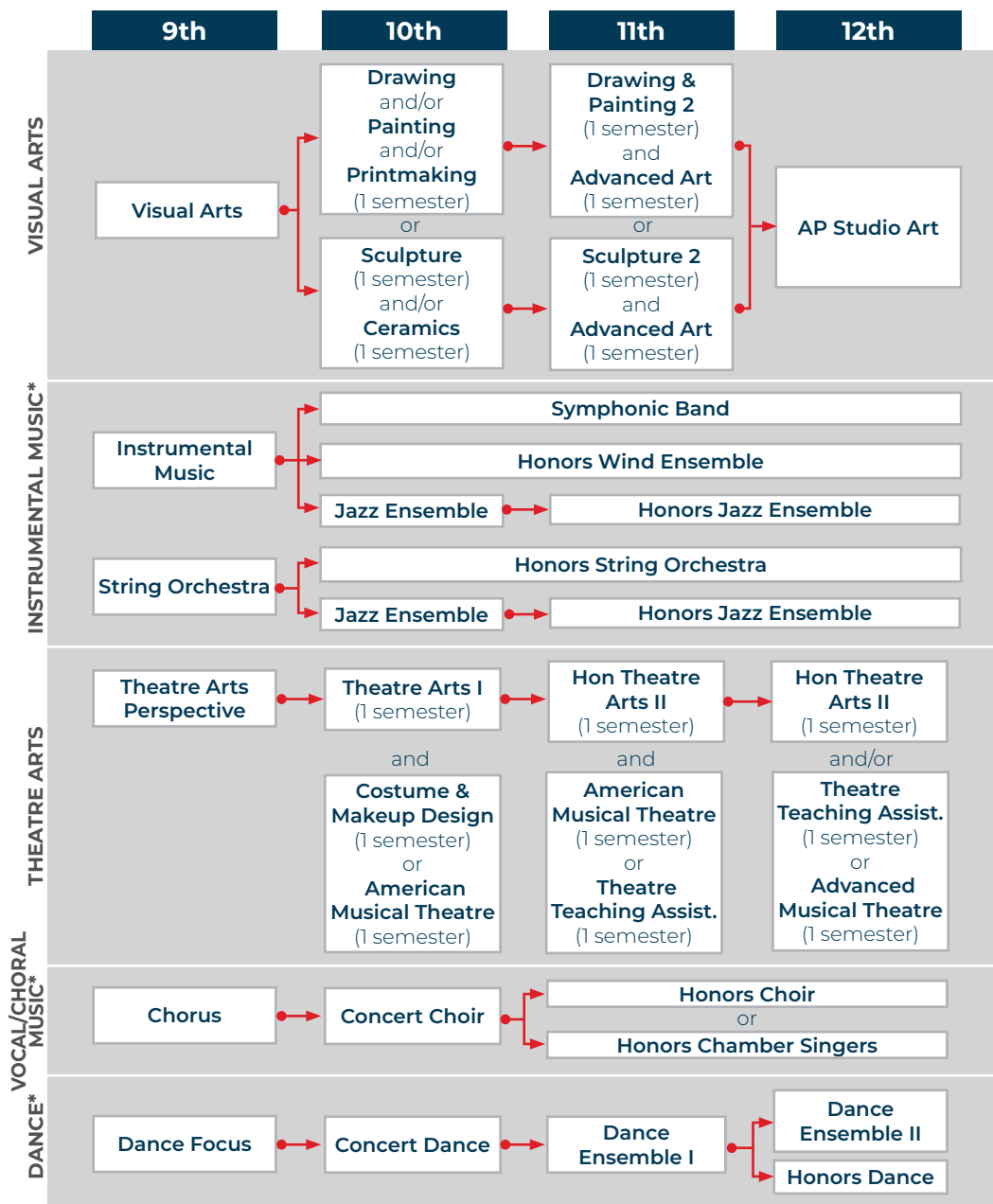

WORLD LANGUAGE SEQUENCE



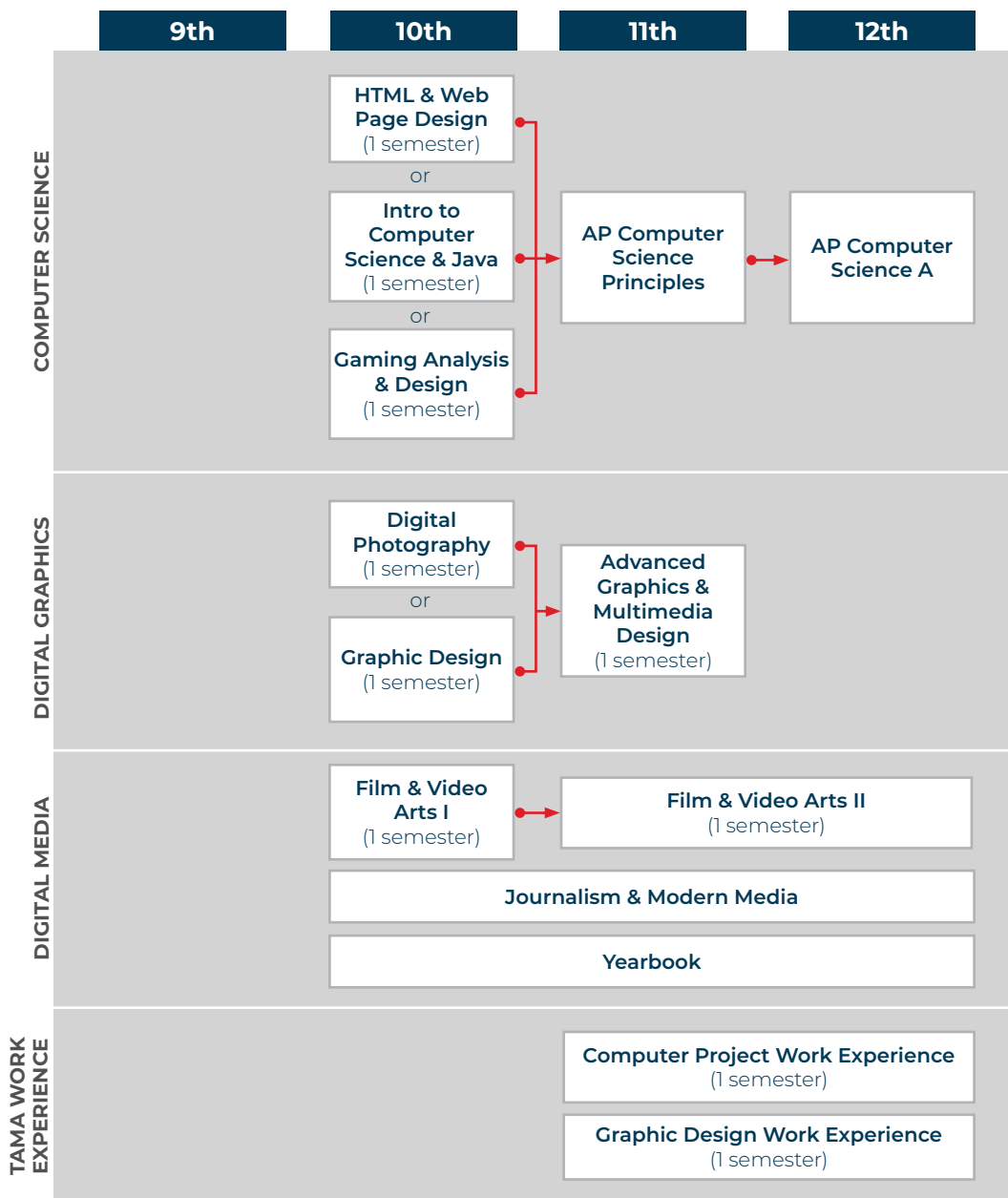
Students with previous World Language experience will be assessed and may be placed in courses beyond first year.
