LOVE OF LEARNING: The mastering of new skills and knowledge and systematically adding to what you know.

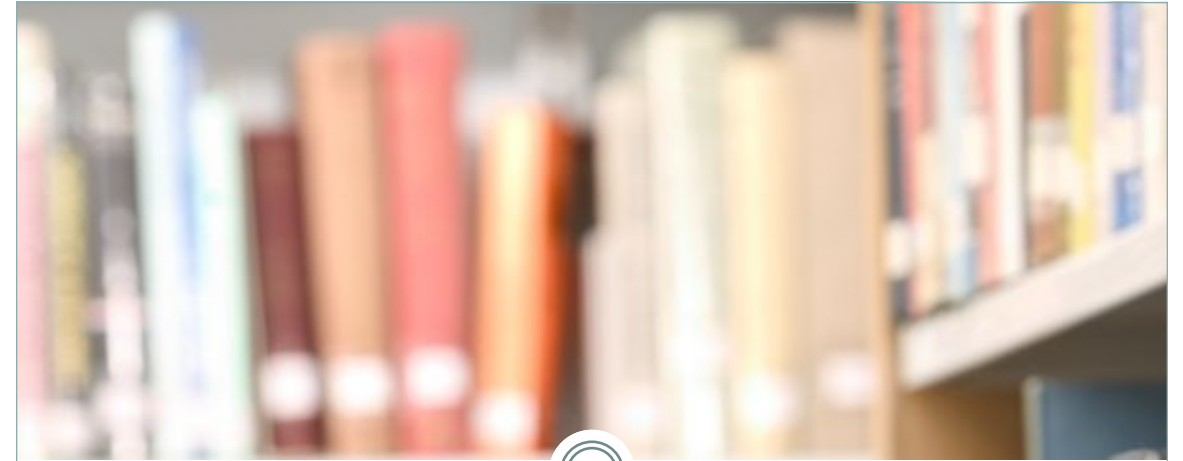
DINNER DISCUSSION: What is a school subject that is difficult to love/be curious about? Brainstorm ways to try and grow.

Fourth grade level academic expectations for absences are as follows:

Please continue to study your spelling words, recitation, and math facts. (Spelling lists are provided on the TCA website and in homework binders).

It is the student’s responsibility to check in with their teachers upon returning to school for other missing assignments, etc. It is also the student’s responsibility to check with their Core-Knowledge teacher (History/Science), for any missed assignments. *Some subjects cannot be re-taught and may require extra time, such as literature, writing, and grammar.*
