

HAMILTON TOWNSHIP SCHOOLS
IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS – K – 12th Grade

Immunizations are to be given by the student's physician. The Hamilton Township Department of Health, 2100 Greenwood Avenue, also offers immunizations to any student who attends a Hamilton Township School and is either uninsured or their insurance does not cover immunizations. An appointment can be made by calling 890-3884.

Disease	Immunization Requirements
Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis (DTP/DTaP) -OR- Diphtheria, Tetanus (Td)	4 doses, with one dose on or after the 4 th birthday. OR any 5 doses. Any 3 doses for students age 7 or older.
Polio (OPV/IPV)	3 doses, with one dose on or after the 4 th birthday. OR any 4 doses. Any 3 doses age 7 or older.
Measles	2 doses, 1 st dose on or after the 1 st birthday.
Rubella	1 dose on or after the 1 st birthday.
Mumps	1 dose on or after the 1 st birthday.
Hepatitis B	3 doses, spacing requirements.
Varicella	1 dose no earlier than the 1 st birthday.
Tuberculin Mantoux	Required for students entering a school system in the U.S. for the first time, if born in a high TB incidence country, and those students transferring to the N.J. school system directly from a high TB incidence country.
Revised: 8/17 Tdap and Meningococcal	Required for all incoming 6 th graders, 11 years or older. Must receive once age 11 is reached.
