Fresh air, fun, and exploration!

This week, our Early Childhood Division was overjoyed when they entered our new Outdoor Exploration Center for the first time! Playing in this space invites a new context for learning. This space provides Ms. Scott and our teachers a place to create intentional learning activities that are difficult to execute indoors There is great value in looking at books about nature in the shade of a tree, pouring (and splashing!) water on the outdoor water table, building extra-large structures with blocks, sand, or mud, collecting leaves, watching a parade of ants, and playing pretend. The possibilities in our new Outdoor Exploration Center are endless! Children are creative, joyful, and engaged in activities that capitalize on their need to move and enthusiasm for doing so while also achieving other curricular goals!

A Few Friendly Reminders:

- The ECD playground will be open from 7:15 a.m. to 7:25 a.m. for families that need occasional early morning care for long work commutes or early work hours.
- Our ECD doors will open again at 7:40 a.m. with the rest of the school to drop your child off on the playground (Early Preschool will be dropped off in room 7).

- Please be mindful of our small parking lot. If you are dropping-off or picking-up, please be quick so we can keep the traffic moving.
- Children will be moved into Extended Care on Brightwheel at 2:45 p.m. Please plan to pick your child up by this time if they are not staying for Extended Care. Students who have not been picked up by 2:45 p.m. will automatically be moved into Extended Care.

High School Application Process & Recommendation Requests

The 8th grade High School application season is beginning and with it comes excitement, anxiety, and anticipation. We are here to support the process and help in any way we can. Individual high school visits to SJES will start in the 1st trimester Road to High School portion of the World Ahead class taught by Patti Peebles and the students will gather essential information to help guide their decision process. It is never too early to access
