Speaking of the first day of school, I know many of you are excitedly waiting to find out who your child's teacher will be this school year. On Friday, August 23, 2024, at 3pm, parents of students in Grades 1-5, may log onto Infinite Campus to view their child's class placement and to update all information. Be sure to look out for a mailing that will include a letter from Mrs. Krudis, Mr. Schwartz and your child's new teacher. You will also find a parent survey and student survey (grades 3-5 only) to return on the first day of school.

Here is some helpful information for the school year:

- **Arrival**

- Grades K-2 will use the Central Administration Doors
- Grades 3-5 will use the Main Entrance Doors
- Doors open at 8:50am and remain open until 9:05 am
- After 9:05am doors will lock, students are considered late and must sign into the Sign in/Sign Out binder located on the table outside of the main doors

- **Dismissal**

- Grades K-2 will use the Central Administration Doors (located to the left of the main doors)
- Grades 3-5 will use the Main Entrance Doors
- Kindergarten students dismiss at 3:10 pm to avoid crowding
- Students in Grades 1-5 are dismissed at 3:15 pm

- **Manor tradition**

- Please submit a 4x6 family photo on the first day of school which will be displayed in our Main Lobby. This picture serves as a reminder that we are all part of the Manor School community.
(please write the names of your children on the back)
- Complete the parent survey and return on the first day of school. Students in grades 3-5 complete and return their survey on the first day of school.
