<u>Turf</u>

The arena has a full-size turf field sectioned into four (4) fields each 30 X 70 yards. Each field rents for \$100/hour per field. All renters can schedule online or contact the Facility Scheduling Coordinator.



Meeting Rooms

There are four (4) meeting rooms available in GTCC. Rooms can be reserved <u>online</u> for \$25/hour and are great for corporate trainings, family events, board meetings and planning sessions.



Walking Lanes



The walking lanes will be open most days when the front desk is staffed. The walking lanes are included in a fitness center membership and a valid GTCC membership badge must be scanned before entry. Day passes may be purchased for \$5. Watch for early morning options at 5:15 AM and a free Walking Wednesday option for community members too. (Opening the second week of September.)



Sport Simulators

The simulators are available to rent for \$40/hour. The wide-screen simulators are available to play a variety of sports. The simulators measure your ball at impact with an overhead ION3 Camera and inflight with a combination of infrared technology and high-speed blue light LED cameras to show your real ball flight, with no delay, for the most realistic ball flight on the market. The simulators are available to play sports including baseball, soccer, zombie dodgeball and much more. Reserve your spot online!








Austin Zurakowski

Events and opportunities are an important part of what we offer. The new space offers more time to invite the community in and take advantage of the turf, gym, and ice rink. Our programs are low cost and do not require a membership or residency. Bring your children, grandchildren, friends and neighbors to try the turf, ice skate or shoot hoops. The community center was built for all and everyone is welcome! Children under 11 years old need to be with an adult. Watch for more classes, programs and special events to be posted soon such as cooking classes and Parents Day Out.

Ice Skating

Ice Skating for any age. Figure skating or hockey skating. (No sticks or pucks allowed.) *Ice Skate Helpers* are available for those who need balance assistance. Rental skates available while supplies last in a variety of sizes. Admission is \$7 per ice skater. Skate rental is \$7 per person.



Climbing Wall

During public climbs we use 3 TruBlue Auto Belays and when available traditional rope belays. Our climbing wall is located in our ice rink; dressing in layers is suggested. Open to ages 5 and up, and climbers must be able to properly fit into harnesses provided and follow certified instructors direction. Admission is \$7 per climber. Climbers must have a waiver on file.



Open Turf Time

The turf is brand new and a great place to run, skip, kick a ball or practice a routine. We'll provide a field along with various equipment such as: soccer balls, nets, bats, wiffle balls, kick balls and more. Turf is open to anyone, but not intended for teams to have organized practice. Spectators are not allowed on the field, but bleacher space is available. Admission is \$7 per person.



Bounce House Nights

We have five bounce houses and rotate three each week for kids to enjoy! Socks are required and can be purchased at the front desk for \$1.00. Bounce Houses are great for children 11 and under, and parents or guardians should be present. Bounce House nights are usually in our gyms. Admission \$7 per child.



Open Gym

During open gyms the basketball hoops will be down and, at times, the volleyball nets up. These times are designated for all and can be used for a friendly game of basketball or drills. Open gym time are a great for little ones to run and play soccer or kick a ball.
