

We are excited to welcome lunch visitors beginning Tuesday, September 3rd!



Please read the information below regarding our Silverlake plan for lunch visitors.

- Lunch visitors will eat with their child in our small cafe, which is closed off from the rest of the cafeteria.
- All visitors will check in at the front reception desk with a photo ID.
- The check-in process will be a little slow at first, so we suggest that you arrive early to ensure that you are ready at your child's lunch time.
- Once you have been checked in, we ask that you wait in the front foyer area for your child's class to pass by on their way to the cafeteria.
- When your child's class arrives, you will walk with them until you reach the doors for the small cafe, where you will enter to enjoy lunch together.
- Visitors are welcome to bring in lunch for themselves and their Silverlake Star.
- If the student needs to buy their lunch from the cafeteria, they will get their lunch from the cafeteria line and meet their lunch guest in the small cafe.
- When lunch is over, your child's teacher will stop by the small cafe to signal that it is time to say your goodbyes. At that time, your child will join their class line and you will make your way to the front desk to check out.

Lunch Visitor Reminders:

- We ask that lunch visitors refrain from taking additional students to the small cafe.
- We also ask that lunch visitors refrain from buying/giving food to a student that is not your child for safety reasons and that you refrain from taking photos or videos of students that are not your child.
- Please say your goodbyes in the small cafe at the end of your child's lunch time. Visitors should not walk back to the classroom with the class but should report directly to the front office to check out.


