

NORTH EAST HIGH SCHOOL TARDY TO *CLASS* POLICY

Being punctual means arriving on time to fulfill one's responsibilities. Employers expect that employees will arrive and be ready to start work on time. North East High School students demonstrate respect, responsibility, and readiness to learn in several ways. The first is to be on time to school and class. It is the expectation that all students are on time. When students do not fulfill this expectation, specific consequences will be assigned as a way to modify their behavior.

1	Warning (MIR)
2	Warning (MIR)
3	Warning (MIR)
4	Twilight Detention (1 day) and Parent Contact (ODR)
6	1 day of MIP (ODR) and Parent Contact
10+	1 day of Twilight School (AS) (ODR) and Parent Contact
2 in one day	MIP and Parent Contact (ODR)

- Students are expected to be in their classrooms when the late bell sounds.
- All classroom doors will be locked at the sound of the late bell.
- Students arriving late to blocks 2, 3, and 4, and returning from lunch, must report to the cafeteria to meet with an administrator and receive a pass to class.
- If no administrator is present, students should report to the main office.
