## OVERVIEW

We want every pupil at Charterhouse to feel Safe, Secure and Supported. There is no problem too small or too big; please do talk to somebody - we are always available to help.

## CARE

If you need advice, or want to talk over a problem, you will usually go to your or Head of House (HH), Deputy Head of House (DHH), Assistant Head of House (AHH), Tutor or House Monitors. Other sources of support include:

### Hunt Health Centre (HHC)

In general, House duty staff will deal with minor medical issues in House. For more serious concerns, or if you wish to see a doctor or nurse, you may ask in House or at the HHC for an appointment to be made.

The HHC provides 24-hour nursing cover. There is a Nurse on call between 20.00 and 07.30 Monday to Friday, and from 18.00 Saturday to 07.30 on Mondays.
