



## **CTAE Non-Discrimination & Pathway Information**

As required by Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act, Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972, the Age Discrimination Act of 1975, and the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, Lee County School System does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, age, or disability in admission to its programs, services, or activities, in access to them, in treatment of individuals, or in any aspect of their operations. The Lee County School System offers career and technical education programs at all secondary education schools (Lee County High School, Lee County 9th Grade Campus, Lee County Middle School East and Lee County Middle School West). These programs are offered under the guidance of certified teachers, and they are designed to prepare youth for a broad range of employment opportunities. The following is a list of programs being offered this year and criteria for admission.

### **Pathways offered at Lee County High School:**

Ag. Leadership in Horticulture, Ag. Leadership In Animal Production, Vet Science, Teaching as a Profession, Therapeutic Services Allied Health, Carpentry, Electrical, Welding, Masonry, JROTC Navy, Law Enforcement Services/Forensic Science, Marketing and Management, Web and Digital Design, Work Based Learning, Youth Apprenticeship, \*Welding Certificate Program, and \*Certified Nursing Assistant Program

\*These two pathways require admittance into Albany Technical College as a dual enrollment student and may require a background check for admission to clinical experiences.

### **Programs offered at Lee County Middle Schools:**

Agriculture Education and Web and Digital Design
