- Parents must send a note to their child's teacher each time they are staying at school for a Community Education class. **YOUR CHILD MUST BE PRE-REGISTERED FOR AFTER SCHOOL CLASSES IN ORDER TO ATTEND.**
- At the end of school day the student(s) should proceed to the assigned classroom to meet their instructor.
- For classes that start later than dismissal time, students will go home and return for the start time. Students are not allowed to remain at school and wait for the start of a later class.
- **FOR SAFETY REASONS: No curbside drop-offs or pickups are allowed.** Students cannot be dismissed prior to the end of the class.
- Please read our general policy statement on the registration form.
- **Please note the ending time of the class your student is enrolled in and pick them up promptly at the end of the class.** Our instructors teach elsewhere and must arrive at their next destination on time. Chronic lateness could result in the non-refundable dismissal from the program.
- The program reserves the right to cancel classes that are under-enrolled, change times/locations when necessary and to substitute teachers.
- Registrations received after the start date of a class will be subject to space availability. **We do not pro-rate.**
- **PLEASE NOTE:** Please notify us if your child has any allergies, dietary restrictions or medical circumstances (including medications) that our instructors should be aware of.
- May we suggest that you pack your student with an extra snack on the days that he/she is taking a class after school.
- No refunds will be granted once a class has started, or in the event a student is dismissed from the program due to behavior issues.
