SCHOOL COMMUNITY

Established in 1899, Jesuit High School of Tampa is a college preparatory school for male students in grades 9-12. Enrollment is limited to approximately 860 students, all of whom commute to Jesuit from throughout a four-county area of greater Tampa Bay. This year, the student body is comprised of 34% students of color, and almost 30% of our students benefit from \$2.4 million in financial aid.

SELECTIVE ADMISSION

Applicants to Jesuit High School endure a highly competitive admissions process. Very few transfer students are accepted, in the interest of cultivating a cohesive four-year experience of formation for our students.

JESUIT FAITH TRADITION

As the Jesuit axiom Ad Majorem Dei Gloriam ("For the Greater Glory of God") indicates, our Catholic faith governs every aspect of a student's formation at Jesuit High School. As such, each Jesuit student is required to study four full years of intensive academic Theology: Introduction to Catholicism, Sacred Scripture, Christian Morality, and Theological Disputations & Christian Discipleship. Additionally, students must make one retreat per academic year.

STUDENT LIFE AT JESUIT

Jesuit students benefit from a vibrant campus life outside the classroom with access to over 40 dynamic student-led organizations. Athletes compete on 12 varsity sports teams that have won 30 State Championships, or cheer on their brothers as members of the Blue Tide student supporters.

Faith: Retreats are planned and led by student members of Peer Ministry who provide their peers guidance for essential personal growth. Altar Servers assist extensively during regular school Mass. Members of the selective Agmen Christi are invited based on qualities of servant leadership, and engage in rigorous weekly formation seminars while also fulfilling extra service expectations under the leadership of the school's President.

Service: Members of Pro-Life Club, Key Club, Students Against Destructive Decisions (SADD), and the Environmental Club are among the many Jesuit clubs that work to serve both the school and the local community through their focus on specific issues related to their respective causes.

Academic Interest and Pre-Professional: Students explore their intellectual passions more deeply through organizations such as the Academic Quiz Bowl, Book Club, Engineering Club, Model United Nations, Mu Alpha Theta (Math), National Honor Society, Robotics, Speech & Debate, and The Company (Business Club).

Performing and Fine Arts: Students engaged in the arts find additional opportunities to pursue their crafts through the Masque drama club, the Jesuit Tiger News Network, The Tiger Newspaper, The Lyre literary magazine, Pep Band, Chamber Orchestra, Chorus, Guitar Ensemble, Don't Feed the Artists art club, and The Tiger Yearbook.

ACCREDITATION RECOGNITION

Jesuit High School is accredited with distinction by Cognia. In its most recent accrediting review, Jesuit earned Cognia's highest honor, **School of Distinction**. Fewer than 5% of schools worldwide that are accredited by Cognia earn School of Distinction recognition.

In its assessment, Cognia determined that Jesuit's Board of Trustees, administration, and faculty are committed to continuous improvement that yields high levels of engagement regarding the school's purpose, leading to student success academically and personally. These efforts ensure a rigorous curriculum supported by educational resources that surpass the expectations of the 21st-Century learner.

MEMBERSHIPS

Jesuit is a member of the National Catholic Educational Association, the Jesuit Schools Network, the Florida High School Athletic Association, the National Association of College Admission Counseling, the Southern Association of College Admission Counseling, and the Bay Area Association of Independent Schools.

GRADING AND CLASS RANK

Each student transcript at Jesuit High School provides a cumulative weighted GPA. The weighted GPA calculation adds 0.5 to each Honors course, and adds 1.0 to each AP course, provided the semester grade is C or higher. Final semester grades are in the form of a full letter grade, with no +/- added.

Jesuit High School does not rank students, nor is a GPA distribution provided. At graduation each year, a valedictorian and salutatorian are recognized for the sole purpose of honoring academic achievement.

HONORS AND AP COURSES

AP and Honors course placement for each student is made by Jesuit High School after teacher recommendation and consultation with their counselors. Students may self-advocate to be placed into a class at the next-highest level of rigor if they seek a more challenging experience than their initial placement provides, but not all such requests are granted. All students enrolled in an AP class are required to take the corresponding AP exam.

In the Jesuit spirit of cura personalis, or "care for the whole person," students work with their counselors to evaluate their entire schedule beyond just their classes, including extracurricular activities, jobs, family responsibilities, and/or service commitments. Students may be encouraged to adjust the number of AP courses based on the evaluation of the entire schedule and recommendations. Jesuit encourages students to seek challenges and also educates them to recognize that a well-rounded, balanced, and a sustainable schedule is necessary for deep mastery of academic material and long-term success.

Please note: only one AP course is available to eligible freshmen (Human Geography).


