Apply Now for Free and Reduced School Meals

Free and reduced meal applications are available online in the <u>Payschools Parent Portal</u>. Additionally, paper applications are available in the school front offices. A new application is required each school year to determine eligibility for free or reduced meals; there is only a 30-day grace period from last school year's approval.

Instructional Fee Waiver: Prior to electronically signing and submitting the online application, please make sure to "check" the boxes in the disclosure section if you are also requesting an instructional fee waiver. This is an important step, as fees will not be waived without this authorization.

For families who are directly certified for free or reduced meals due to their eligibility through SNAP, TANF or Medicaid, you will receive a Direct Certification Notification from our Nutrition Services Partner, Milford Exempted Village Schools.

Please note that action is required - you must sign and return the Fee Waiver Permission on the bottom of that form - in order for instructional fees to be waived.

SENIORS:

- This is our first <u>Weekly Application Update</u> that has also been shared with Seniors via Canvas. The <u>Weekly Application Update</u> helps seniors and their families navigate the college application process and highlights time-sensitive information and deadlines. The <u>College Application Guide</u> is also an extremely helpful resource.
- Please note that the two programs scheduled for Tuesday, September 24th: College
 Application Process at 6:30 PM and College Financial Aid Information Session at 7:30
 PM have been rescheduled to a week earlier, September 17th to accommodate
 Homecoming Week festivities. Every Senior (guardians too) that plans to apply to
 college should attend the session on the college application process. The financial aid
 session is only for students and guardians who plan to apply for financial aid. Both
 events will be held in Pendery Auditorium. Please contact Cynthia Meis, Director of

 either of these events.
- Parent/Guardian Letters of Recommendation for the College Application Process are due to Mrs. Meis and Mrs. Bunton by October 1st. To help the College Counselors advocate as strongly as possible for students as part of the college application process, parents or guardians are encouraged to write a parent/guardian letter of recommendation. By highlighting their student's best qualities & characteristics, this letter helps the counselors write *their* letters of recommendation. These letters are completely confidential – they will not be shared with the student or admission officers and substance is more important than style. In other words, feel free to craft the letter in whatever format you choose, and you may be as informal or formal as you like. Some information to consider and questions to get you started is linked_<u>HERE</u>.
- For Seniors, the beginning of the school year also means we need to start thinking about next year! Please encourage your student to sign up for their appointment by September 15th. For Seniors, Mrs. Meis works with last names A-K and meetings with her can be scheduled <u>HERE</u>. Mrs. Bunton works with last names L-Z and meetings with her can be scheduled <u>HERE</u>.

- Individual student check-ins and graduation plan reviews will be starting soon! We will begin with seniors in early September and meet with all students by the end of 1st semester.
- CCP classes are getting started, please be aware of course drop deadlines at your college/university. You must communicate any changes in your college schedule to your High School Counselor. You must be enrolled in enough classes to be a full time student for the year especially for athletics!
- The School Counseling Department will host therapy dogs/animals for students and staff during the 24-25 School Year. Due to the success of these events, students will be required to sign up for time with the therapy animals during Flex, with options for visits twice a month. Occasionally a teacher may invite the dogs into their classroom for a walk around.
 - Not all dogs are hypoallergenic. There is no food or drink allowed in the Pendery Lobby with the dogs. Therapy dogs are not the responsibility of Wyoming City Schools, and the student and family accept all liability in having their student participate.
 - If you do not want your student to interact with the dogs, or if your student is afraid or concerned around the dogs, we certainly understand, and want to keep the school environment safe and comfortable. <u>Please contact your student's school counselor and</u> we will work to ensure distance is kept.

- **WHS Main Office Hours:** WHS Office Hours are Monday-Friday 7:30 a.m. 3:30 p.m.
- **<u>Arrival:</u>** We will open the doors for students daily at 7:40 a.m.
- **<u>School Hours:</u>** Our school day runs between 8:00 a.m. 3:00 p.m.
- **<u>Tardy Bell</u>**: The tardy bell rings to start the day at 8:00 a.m.
- Flex: Flex days will be on Tuesday and Thursday
- <u>Cell Phones:</u> All student cell phones must be placed in the teacher designated area during academic times (i.e., instructional class periods and study halls). Students are permitted to have phones during Flex, in the hallways during class changes and in the cafeteria during lunch.
- **<u>Updated Schedules:</u>** All students received an updated schedule on Wednesday, August 14th. Our counselors are working diligently to process any recent requests. Thank you for your patience.
