Students in third, fourth, and fifth grade will be involved with what our known as ILEARN checkpoints throughout the school year, with the first one slated for later on this month. In addition to this, there are new state mandates that were brought about through legislative action regarding the IREAD3 assessments which all second and third grade students will be taking this year.
