

Admission Process

step by step

Create an Applicant Profile

The application fee is \$150, and our deadline is November 30, after which there is a \$50 late fee. We announce admission decisions in December for PK2–4 and March for Bridging K.

Complete the Attribute Form

The Attribute Form is to help you describe your child's personality and learning style. For PK2, this must be done by a parent. For PK3+, it must be done by an unrelated adult.

Participate in a Playdate

PK3+ applicants will be assigned a school play date. While your child plays, you can hear a presentation from our staff to learn more about our program. PK2 kids are exempt.

Join Us for a Campus Tour

You truly don't know if a school is right for your family until you get on campus. We recommend visiting at least once to find out if Blue House Preschool is a good match.

Apply for Financial Assistance

Complete a Parent Financial Statement by November 30. We consider more than just income, including dependents, tuition expenses, and unusual expenses.

Look for the Green Check Marks

Check your checkmarks! Be sure to refer to the admission portal to make sure you didn't miss any steps. You will see a green checkmark on the completed steps.
