

# Georgia Milestones: Performance Across Time and by Student Group


The Georgia Milestones Assessment System (GMAS) is a set of summative exams designed to measure how well students have learned the knowledge and skills outlined in the state-adopted content standards. The graphs below show performance across time and by student group for Creekland MS. The first graph summarizes performance on the Mathematics End of Grade tests, followed by a graph for the Language Arts End of Grade tests. Each bar represents the percentage of students in Grades 6 to 8 who scored Proficient or higher on the exam.
