You can apply for this clearance online at https://www.aps.edu/community/volunteer-with-aps. You can attend field trips as a sponsor with this clearance.

If you want to volunteer in the above ways AND be a PREFERRED volunteer for field trips as a lead/preferred volunteer then the best option for you is an Unsupervised School Volunteer Clearance. Safety Supports

To ensure our continued site safety at the beginning of each year we practice four emergency drills. Two fire drills, a shelter-in-place drill, and an evacuation drill. We will be conducting our Evacuation Emergency Drill on Wednesday, September 18th. Our Evacuation Drill guidelines require us to fully evacuate our school site to a safe location. This drill will occur in the morning, to ensure students are not walking in the heat of the day. We anticipate the entire drill to last approximately 30 minutes. Please visit with your students to remind them of the importance of drills and listening/following directions provided by their teachers. Wearing tennis shoes is a plus!

Please remember that in our parent drop-off/pick-up lines, we ask families to stay in their vehicles. If you would like to give your students a hug and kiss goodbye or a hug to greet them at the end of the day, please park in the parking lot and walk to the front of the school. When families exit their vehicles in line it adds an additional risk for injury as well as significantly slows down the line.
