THE SCHOOL



Wando High School with an enrollment of approximately 2,600 students is located on a 100 acre campus in Mount Pleasant, South Carolina. Wando High School is a large, public non-magnet high school serving a diverse population of students in grades 9 - 12 with a comprehensive academic program offering more than 200 courses. Wando has maintained a reputation of academic excellence while providing rigorous standards in all areas for college and career readiness.

More than 25% of our students excel in the visual and performing arts. The Athletic Department has 38 teams competing in 23 sports. There are a wide variety of extracurricular activities including club sports, campus clubs, and honor societies.

Throughout the year, our students raise funds, collect resources, and serve alongside community members at various charities and events in support of those in need. Our students are encouraged to be involved in Wando life and "Walk the Warrior Way" with integrity, compassion, and personal responsibility.

FACULTY AND PROFESSIONAL STAFF

- Professional staff members have an average of 16 years of educational experience.
- 76% of the faculty and professional staff hold masters or other advanced degrees.
- 5 professional staff members are National Board Certified Teachers.

NOTABLE ACHIEVEMENTS

- Eighty-eight percent of the 2024 graduating class planned to attend four-year colleges/universities, two-year colleges or technical colleges.
- Members of the class of 2024 were awarded over \$19.5 million in scholarships.
- Two hundred twenty-eight seniors in the Class of 2024 were named Charleston County School District Board Scholars earning a 4.25 GPA or higher.
- Four Wando students were named as 2024 Finalists in the National Merit Scholarship Corporation Competition.
- There were 47 Early Awards recipients in the Class of 2024 for the South Carolina Palmetto Fellows Scholarship.
- Seniors took 629 dual credit courses with a passage rate of 96% during the 2023-2024 school year.
- Two senior students received military academy appointments to the U. S. Coast Guard Academy.
- There are 530 members of the Advanced Placement Academy.
- Twenty-six seniors in the Class of 2024 received special Advanced Studies certificates at graduation due to earning six or more AP credits.
- To graduate from high school requires earning 24 course credits. The Class of 2024 earned an average of 29 credits.
- The average GPA of the Class of 2024 was 3.84.
- The Seal of Biliteracy was awarded to 88 Wando students.
- Wando's AFJROTC Unit received an Outstanding Unit with Merit Award having served 1,836 hours of community service.
- Legend, the Wando yearbook, was awarded the Best Yearbook in South Carolina for the third year in a row and Tribal Tribune was named the best newspaper in South Carolina by the South Carolina Scholastic Press Association.
- Wando's Marching Band is the South Carolina 5A State Champion for the fifteenth time.
- A team of four Wando students competed in the Spring South Carolina Finance Challenge and won first place.
