- **Application must be approved prior to a student arriving late or leaving early.**
- Application will cover the entire school year, unless the privilege is revoked by a parent or administrator.
- If an application is not approved, students will be scheduled for study hall.

1. Students must demonstrate positive academic achievement and progress, consistent attendance, good citizenship, and no significant violations of the school code of conduct.
  - a. A student must maintain a C or better grade in all classes, monitored at IPR and end of each marking period. A student who is not maintaining this academic standard will lose this privilege for the remainder of the semester.
2. Rising 11th graders must have acquired a minimum of 13.75 credits by the end of their sophomore year; rising 12th graders must have acquired a minimum of 20 credits by the end of their junior year.
3. Students must provide their own transportation
4. Students who are approved for late arrival must check in with the Greeter daily upon arrival.
5. Students who exercise the privilege of late arrival are not to arrive at school before 8:06am. Students who arrive prior to 8:13am will report to the cafeteria. It is expected that students will arrive on time for their 2nd period class. A student who is late to 2nd period two times will lose this privilege for the remainder of the semester.
6. Students who exercise this privilege for early release are not to remain on school grounds after 1:40pm.
7. Students will lose this privilege if found helping other students to leave school property without permission.
8. Administration shall retain the right to revoke this privilege for any behavior that violates the rules and guidelines for students as put forth in the student code of conduct.
9. Students are responsible to attend class on time and to know if the daily schedule has been modified, including class meetings and Forum schedules.
