

"RIDING THE READING WAVE" ACCELERATED READER



OUR GOAL FOR 1ST SEMESTER IS 8,000 BOOKS!

Last Year 2023-2024:

- 1st semester, we read 6,086 books independently at 80% or higher!
- 2nd semester, we read 8,537 books independently at 80% or higher!

Please encourage your child to read nightly to increase their independent reading stamina!

EXPECTATIONS:

- All 1st quarter goals were set for 1st-6th grade students using their i-ready data.
- Quarter 1 runs from 8/12-10/9
- Goals are entirely met if the student earns their points, has a testing average of 80% or higher, and reads within their Reading Range (ZPD).

GOALS/INCENTIVES:

- Our 1st-semester school-wide AR goal is 8,000 books. This is a huge goal and will take everyone encouraging their child to reach their AR goal and keep reading even after achieving it! The top 3 AR students from each grade level will be awarded at the end of the year during Awards Day!
- We will have a school-wide incentive to be held during PE in December.
- The total for each grade level will be displayed in the halls so students can see our progress. Please remember that 80% or higher on an AR test is a passed quiz, and we only count quizzes passed towards our 8,000 books goal.
- We will also offer a big incentive for students in grades 1-6 who earn their 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th quarter goals combined in May. Last year was a beach trip. More information will come on this end-of-the-year incentive!
