

Delay & Cancellation Chart for 2024-2025

The 5 Rules for success to follow when knowing if it is a Traditional 8-period school day or Block 4-period school day:

1. If we Delay, follow the 2-Hour Delay schedule for that day. We have a 2-hour delay schedule for Traditional days and Block days.
2. If we Cancel on a Traditional 8-period school day (M, T, or F), we will not make up the day.
3. If we Cancel on a Wednesday Block day periods 1, 3, 5 & 7, the day B1 is moved to Thursday.
4. If we Cancel on a Thursday Block day periods 2, 4, 6, & 8, the day B2 is moved to Friday.
5. College Credit Plus equals Green for Go. If a student needs to attend a college course and there is a scheduling conflict, you may sign out to leave.

Examples to refer to for knowing what day we are having a Traditional 8-period school day or Block 4-period school day:
