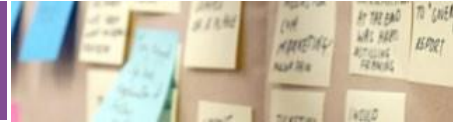


Business, Marketing, and Finance Career Cluster
