MEASUREMENT TOPIC: Explain the Integumentary System

4	In addition to Score 3, the student makes in-depth inferences and applications. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Demonstrate understanding of a pathological condition impacting the integumentary system and treatment options (medications, surgical procedures, etc.) for that condition.
3	The student can: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Construct an explanation of the relationship between the integumentary system and other organ systems in maintaining homeostasis.• Describe how the structural organization of the integumentary system supports its function.
2	The student can: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Explain the differences of the four tissue types: epithelial, connective, muscular, and nervous.• Explain how differences in cell structure leads to differences in the function and organization of tissues.
