Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:12-15, notice is hereby given that the Lyndhurst Board of Education is seeking qualified candidates to fill a vacant seat on the Board of Education.

This term will run until midnight on December 31, 2024. The position will be placed on the ballot at the November 2024 General Election.

**Qualifications**

In accordance with N.J.S.A. 18A:12-1, all candidates must:

1. Be a citizen of the United States of America;
2. Be at least eighteen (18) years of age;
3. Be able to read and write;
4. Be a resident of Lyndhurst for at least one (1) year preceding the date of the appointment;
5. Not be disqualified as a voter pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:4-1;
6. Be a registered voter in Lyndhurst;
7. Not hold office as a mayor or member of the governing body of Lyndhurst;
8. Not be disqualified from membership on the Board due to conviction of a crime or offense listed in N.J.S.A. 18:12-1;
9. Have no interest in any contract with, or claim against, the Board;
10. If selected, undergo a criminal background check pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:12-1.2 and must pass the check which must be completed within 30 days of being selected as a successful candidate; and
11. Not simultaneously hold two elective offices.
