

INFORMATION ON YOUR SCHOOL-BASED HEALTH CENTER

Your school has a School-Based Health Center, operated by the school's community partner, CFA (Child & Family Agency of Southeastern Connecticut)!

CFA has been operating SBHCs for over 30 years and operates over 20 School-Based Health Centers in this region, with a Nurse Practitioner (APRN) and Mental Health Clinician (therapist) at each location.



The School-Based Health Center is different from the school nurse's office and a community primary care provider (PCP) but works collaboratively with them to provide comprehensive care for students.



Health insurance is billed for services provided, but there is no cost to the family (no co-pays, deductible costs, or out-of-pocket expenses). **Tricare insurance is accepted



Same-day medical appointments are available to registered students! Please note that we request that registrations are updated annually.
