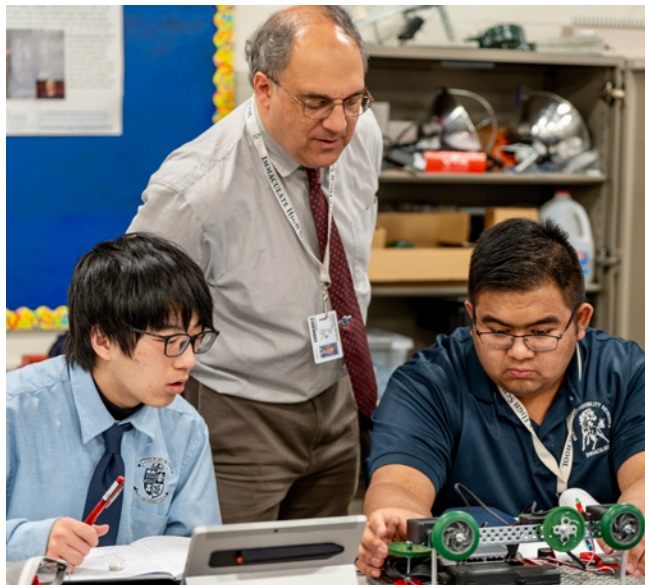




...in a Thriving Family

Find Support...

What does it take to design the ideal high school experience? The answer is clear: **keep the focus on the students.** You will be taught to take the initiative and to find the support you need to ensure your success and overall well-being. Learning to self advocate is critical for college success and you will find the culture of our school is one where you will develop the courage to ask for help so that you can be your best.

Our teachers are available every day after school to provide extra-help. The student-to-counselor ratio of 95:1 is far lower than the national average of over 400:1. This means that our team will not only help you to navigate the complex college admissions process, but they will be accessible as you navigate all aspects of high school life.

We rise by lifting others which is evident when a senior Field Hockey "Big Sister" welcomes a new member to the team, a peer tutor helps you prepare for your AP Biology exam or friends show up opening night to watch you on stage.

By ensuring the health of your mind, body and spirit, you are more likely to perform at your best. A school nurse, therapist and strength and conditioning coach are all on staff to support your overall health and development.

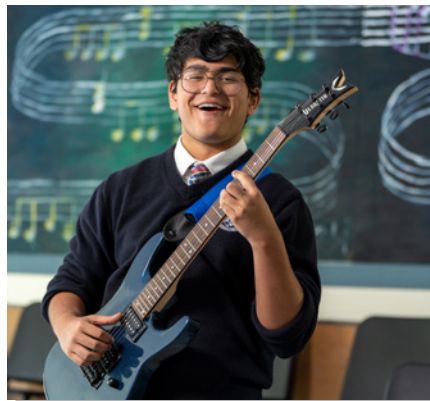
Take Center Stage...
