Principal Report – Mr. Lichey

- **The Wyandot Way- Be respectful, be responsible, be safe, be a problem solver**
- **Wyandot went from 1 star to 3 and a half stars.**
- **Principal and Assistant Principal talk about data of every student every month with every teacher.**
- **Individualized instruction in the classrooms**
- **Positive behavior intervention supports- a committee was put together in the school that created a PBIS Handbook. New posters will be hung around the school in specific locations (ex. Restroom, Hallway, Cafeteria, Playground, Classroom) Class goals on number of kids who earn stars. Assembly once a month to motivate kids. Focusing on experiences not stuff to build relationships.**
