SCHOOL POLICY UPDATE

Cell Phones & Personal Electronic Devices

Prior Lake Middle Schools have adopted an "Away for the Day" policy for cell phones and other personal electronic devices. Students may not use their cell phones or other personal electronic devices from the first class bell (7:20) to the last class bell (2:06). For more information on this new policy please review the <u>family communication</u> sent home last week.

Student Dress Code

The school board has updated the district <u>Dress Code Policy</u>. Students are encouraged to wear clothing that is suitable for the weather, ensures health and safety, and is appropriate for school activities, whether in physical education or classroom settings. Clothing should cover from one armpit to the other and down to approximately midthighs, front and back. If wearing see-through or mesh garments, appropriate coverage underneath that meets the dress code requirements is necessary.

STUDENT DROP OFF & PICK UP INFORMATION


For families who will drive their student(s) to school, please review the plan for your school to make the experience easier for your family.


Morning Procedure

- Students being dropped off must be dropped off at the SOUTH DOORS (Pool entrance @ HOMS and the lower level Marquee entrance @ TOMS).
- Students can be dropped off as early as 6:45am. All students arriving early are to congregate in the cafeteria at their assigned building. Breakfast is available for the those who are interested.
- Students are released from the cafeteria at 7:10am to enter hallways and walk to classrooms
- Cars are not permitted in the bus loop
- Plan your arrival time carefully, class starts at 7:20am and traffic picks up around the school after 7am

Afternoon Procedures

- Students are released at 2:06pm
- Parents should pick up students at the SOUTH DOORS
- Student and bus traffic may cause delays, please be patient during dismissal times
