As the parent of a student in a Title 1 funded school you have the right to request information about your child's classroom teacher's qualifications.

Requests concerning the teacher's qualifications should be made to the building principal. The parents shall be notified in writing if their child has been taught for a period of four or more consecutive weeks by a teacher not deemed to be "highly qualified."
