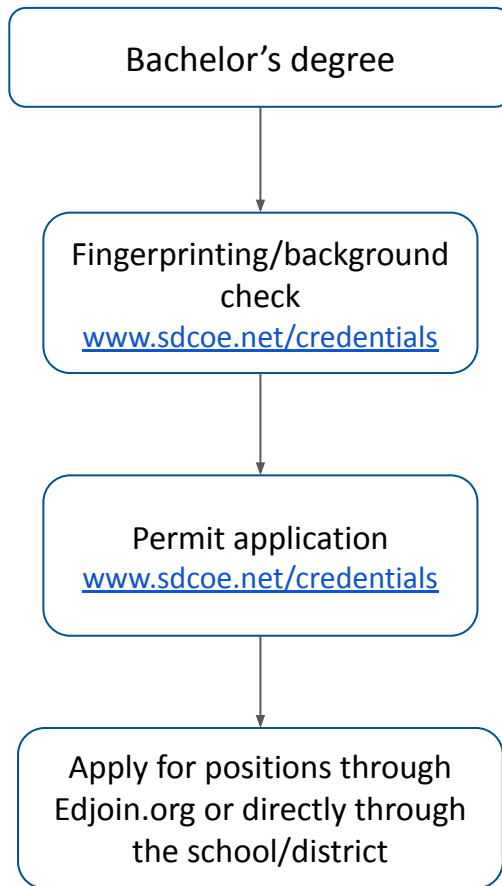




# Emergency 30-Day Substitute Teaching Permit (Substitute Teaching Permit) - CA

The Emergency 30-Day Substitute Teaching Permit authorizes the holder to serve as a day-to-day substitute teacher in any classroom in California, including preschool, kindergarten, and grades 1-12, or in classes organized primarily for adults.

## TIPS!

*Substitute teaching is a great way to better determine if teaching is the career for you as well as allowing you to get to know a school/district.*

*30-day substitute teacher permit allows the holder to serve as a substitute for no more than 30 days for any one teacher during the school year or no more than 20 days in a school year for a special education teacher*

*The Basic Skills Requirement (BSR) has changed! Many teacher candidates used to take the CBEST. Now a bachelor's degree from a regionally-accredited institution eliminates this requirement for most credentials and the 30-Day Substitute Teacher Permit. [CTC - Basic Skills Requirement](#)*
