
There are many pathways to becoming an educator. Here's a quick guide to...

Special Subjects Credential - CA

The Preliminary or Clear Special Subjects Teaching Credential authorizes the holder to teach the subject named on the credential in grades K–12 inclusive, and classes organized primarily for adults. Subjects include Aviation Flight Instruction, Aviation Ground Instruction, Basic Military Drill, Driver Education and Training, Limited Driver Training, and Reserve Officer Training Corps (ROTC).

Special Teaching Authorization in Physical Education

- The Special Teaching Authorization in Physical Education authorizes the holder to teach physical education courses in basic military drill and physical fitness training in grades 12 and below, and classes organized primarily for adults.
- Authorization is limited to the areas of basic military drill and physical fitness training.
