
There are many pathways to becoming an educator. Here's a quick guide to...

Career Technical Education (CTE) Credential - CA

The Preliminary Designated Subjects CTE Teaching Credential authorizes the holder to teach in the specific credential subject up to 12th grade and in classes organized primarily for adults, in career technical, trade or vocational courses. The Clear Designated Subjects CTE Teaching Credential authorizes the holder to teach English learners in Specially Designed Academic Instruction Delivered in English (SDAIE) as part of career technical, trade or vocational courses.

While you are teaching you will also complete the following:

- Credential coursework
- CPR for infant, child and adult certification
- U.S. Constitution coursework equivalency or exam This is typically met during undergraduate general education coursework.
- Health education
- English Language Waiver
