

Adult Education Credential - CA

The Preliminary or Clear Designated Subjects Adult Education Teaching Credential authorizes the holder to teach the subjects named on the credential in courses organized primarily for adults. In addition, the holder may serve as a substitute in courses organized primarily for adults for not more than 30 days for any one teacher during the school year. <u>CTC - Adult Education Credential</u>

- U.S. Constitution coursework equivalency or exam *This is typically met during undergraduate general education coursework.*
