The Caledonia-Mumford Central School District, a member of the Genesee Valley BOCES, is located on a 50-acre site in the village of Caledonia. Recent capital projects have provided excellent instructional areas, improved campus security, and expanded our extensive computer network. The Hamilton Field Sports Complex, with its all purpose synthetic turf field and all-weather track, is the premier student athletic facility in Section V. The Cal-Mum Activboard Initiative has brought interactive technology into the classroom instruction. Approximately 800 students are housed in two separate buildings located on one central campus.

The Caledonia-Mumford School District offers a comprehensive academic program. School Report Cards indicate that Cal-Mum students consistently score well above state and area averages. Cal-Mum is actively involved in School-To-Work programs. Our commitment to creating a “sense of belonging” and school spirit is evidenced by the fact that 70% of our students are participating in extracurricular activities. Academic teams have repeatedly finished in the top of their competition. Athletic teams have advanced to the Sectional and State levels.
