We are the flagship school for the Sky Partnership with KIPP Houston Public Schools and YES Prep Public Schools, two high-performing charter management organizations, to expand middle and high school choices and opportunities for SBISD students. We have ongoing partnerships with College Community Career, Emerge, OneGoal and Posse organizations that foster a collegegoing culture with high school students and families.

An expanded grading scale includes Special
