Community & School Information

Spring Woods High School (SWHS) is a comprehensive public high school (grades 9-12) offering challenging, college bound high school experience for a diverse student body where 80% of students qualify for free/reduced lunch. Through high quality teaching, the integration of technology, and a wide range of electives and enrichment experiences our students are challenged to understand and engage in our global society.

SWHS has nearly tripled the percentage of students offered college scholarships, reaching \$12 million in 2024. Through strong relationships with area businesses and Colleges, SWHS provide students with job shadowing opportunities, mentors and college scholarship support. Our partnership with Houston Community College offers students a full Early College program where they can earn college credit hours while still in high school. Specialized programs are available for students with specific career/academic interest: Health Occupations Students of America, highly competitive debate and UIL academic teams.

From Fall 2015 to Spring 2024, a district high school housed a YES Prep Public School charter on its campus. That partnership is now concluded. For the Class of 2025 only, former YES Prep students who choose to attend Spring Woods will keep the class rank they received from YES Prep at the end of Junior year. This is the rank they will use for applications through February of their Senior year.

We have ongoing partnerships with College Community Career, Emerge, OneGoal and Posse organizations that foster a college-going culture with low income, first generation high school students and families. Students must complete the State of Texas Foundation High School Graduation Program with an Endorsement that requires a total of 26 credits as follows:
