After-School Clay Class

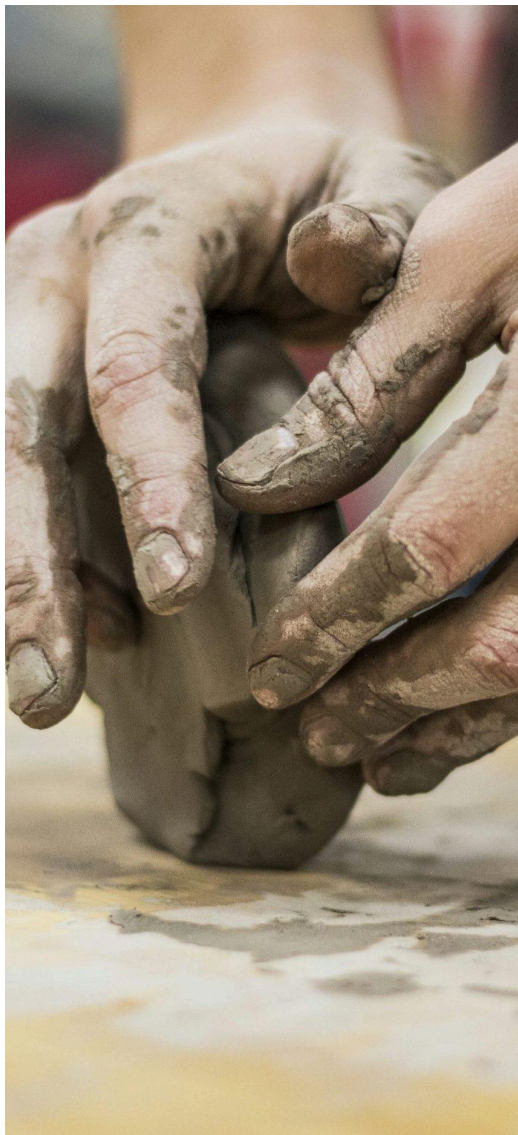
Grades 1-2, Fall session
