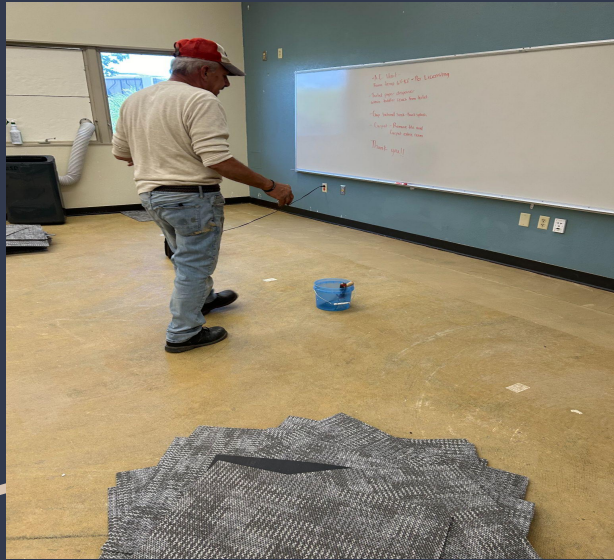

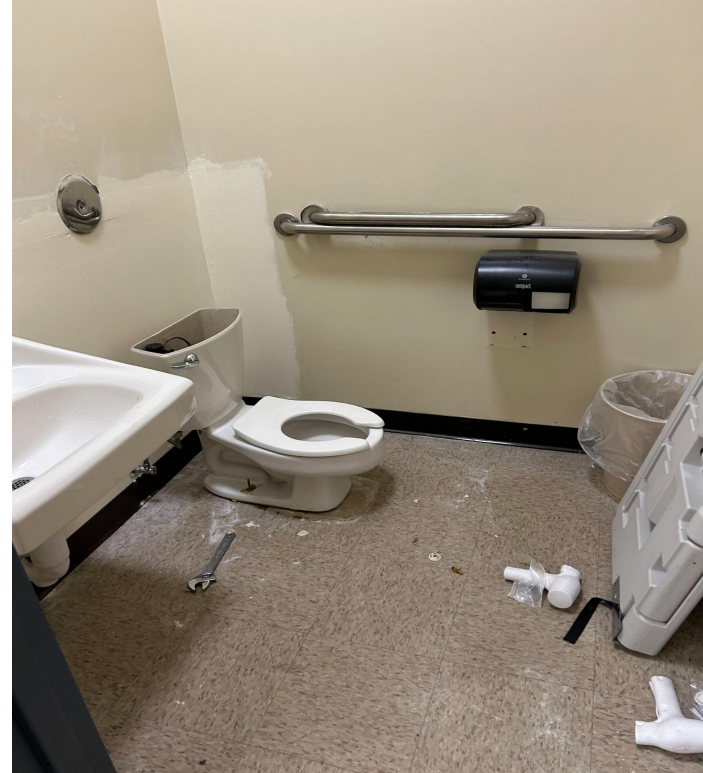

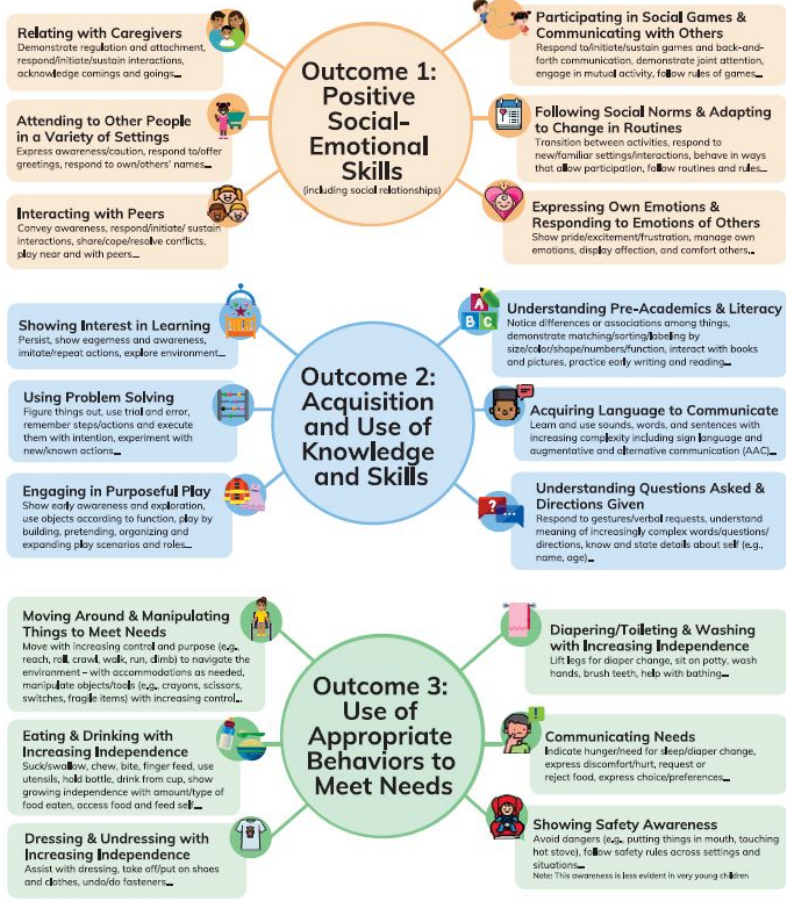
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BREADTH OF THE THREE CHILD OUTCOMES

The three child outcomes, measured by early intervention and early childhood special education systems, encompass functional skills and behaviors that are meaningful for a child's participation in everyday routines. They cut across developmental domains to represent the integrated nature of how children develop, learn, and thrive. The breadth of these outcomes provides a framework for describing and consistently measuring children's functional skills and behaviors across settings and situations.



This year ADE rolled out a new system of evaluating 3-5 year old students. For the past several years we have used Teaching Strategies Gold (TSG). This data was collected using observations, notes, pictures and checklists. This data was entered into the TSG website.

ADE changed to the Three Child Outcomes, data is collected the same way but now reported through our student management system (Synergy)

The preschool team decided to keep portfolios for each child and also to use these 18 standard for our quarterly progress report to our families.

Last year our goal was to:

ECQUIP Goals-

- Learn about the new ADE “Three Child Outcomes”
- Understand the rating system
- Learn to report data using Synergy along with storing data and informing parents about the data.

We conquered this goal and shared with districts around us.

24-25 Preschool Focus



Goals for 24-25

- Work on process and procedures of Child Find, placement of students, Evaluations and how to continue our learning with preschool staff at 4 different sites.
- Continue to refine along with ADE the “Three Child Outcomes” data. Last year was our first year with data entry and a huge learning curve as to when and why to input data. I am hoping ADE has learned from this first year and refined the expectations for this year.
- Work on MVES playground- I will be working on a grant to add fake grass as well as sidewalks for tricycle riding and gravel to our playground.
- Start the conversation with LVES leadership about their kindergarten playground what they would like to see happen on that campus.
- The teachers will be refining their lesson planning and working on reflecting on “What is the evidence of learning and what are the next steps with this evidence?”.
