What is an AP Exam?

AP Exams are College Level exams that include multiple choice and free response questions, or portfolios.

The exams vary in style and length, as well as in the type of free-response questions based on the subject matter course.

They might include long- or short-essay questions, document analysis, recorded responses, listening and response, or a curated art portfolio.

How do I register for my AP Exam(s)?

Complete 2 Steps

- Connect to the AP Classroom for each AP Course.
- Complete registration & payment (or set up payment plan) on WHS Total Registration Portal www.TotalRegistration.net/AP/447565

How does taking an AP Exam benefit me?

AP Exams are opportunities for you to earn college credit in high school with a qualifying score

Different colleges & universities have differing qualifying scores (usually a 3, 4, or 5) which may allow you to skip a class in college; to check what a qualifying score is by course of college/university, go to:

- Go to myap.collegeboard.org,
- login** or create a new account if you do not have one, and
- click the yellow "join a course" button (see Join Codes on screen or in your Canvas)

- once recovered, write it down your email/password somewhere secure & preferably backed up to the cloud





