Lake City Heating & Cooling Inc. PROPOSES TO:

- A. Provide services as specified in this agreement on equipment listed. If unusual conditions exist, we would revise the contract to service the equipment more or less frequently as needed.
- B. Check and clean all heating, cooling, dehumidification and exhaust systems as listed and check fan and control operation.
- C. Provide preferential service to agreement holders for other types of service available through *Lake City Heating & Cooling Inc.*
- D. Provide report indicating what services and repairs (if necessary) were performed during regularly scheduled maintenance visits. The report may also include recommendations to provide greater operating efficiency for equipment listed in this agreement. Coil cleaning is a part of this agreement and will be addressed as needed or once per year.
- E. All materials required in the periodic performance of maintenance for equipment listed in this agreement shall be furnished by *Lake City Heating & Cooling Inc.* at no additional cost to the Client. Any parts or labor required in excess of those needed for periodic maintenance, i.e. repairs and/or other services shall be at the Client's expense (except for original installations, where parts are covered by the manufacturer's warranty). The Client agrees to pay *Lake City Heating & Cooling Inc.* for labor and material at *Lake City Heating & Cooling Inc.*'s current list price
- F. Any additional repairs in excess of the scheduled maintenance will need written authorization from the Client or his representative prior to ordering parts and completion of the repairs.

THE CLIENT AGREES TO:

- A. Maintain operation of listed equipment per *Lake City Heating & Cooling Inc's* instructions.
- B. Notify *Lake City Heating & Cooling Inc*. of any changes in operating environment or changes in operational performance for equipment listed in this agreement.
- C. Allow only authorized personnel of *Lake City Heating & Cooling Inc*. to work on equipment listed in this agreement.

GENERAL PROVISIONS:

- A. Planned Inspection and Maintenance Service will be performed during *Lake City Heating & Cooling Inc.'s* normal working hours. For emergency service requested outside normal working hours by the Client, the Client agrees to pay after hour rates for the time period when such service is rendered.
- B. Agreement shall begin on the date indicated for a term of one year and shall continue from year to year. The agreement price may be adjusted annually to reflect changes in labor and material costs.
- C. Agreement may be terminated by either party by giving **30** days written notice prior to anniversary date of original agreement. Non-payment for services rendered also constitutes grounds for termination of this agreement.
- **D.** Lake City Heating & Cooling Inc. shall not be liable for any delay of failure to furnish service do to fire, flood, strike, lockout, or dispute with workman, inability to obtain materials, commotion, war, act of God, or any other cause beyond the reasonable control of Lake City Heating & Cooling Inc.
