Stein High Graduation Requirements

- Students must earn 135 credits total, and complete all subjects as outlined below.
- 130 credits will be earned in the required subject areas, 25 electives.
- Students must complete and present the **Student Portfolio** (elective credits).
- Students must earn **20 credits in residency** at Stein.



30 credits - English

30 credits - Social Studies

20 credits - Science (Biology & Physical Science)

20 credits - Math (*including Algebra 1*)

10 credits - Fine Arts

25 credits - Electives (*including Physical Education*)

Total 135 credits
