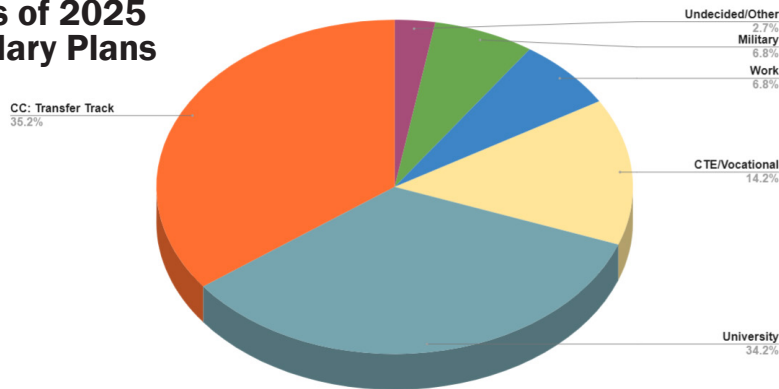

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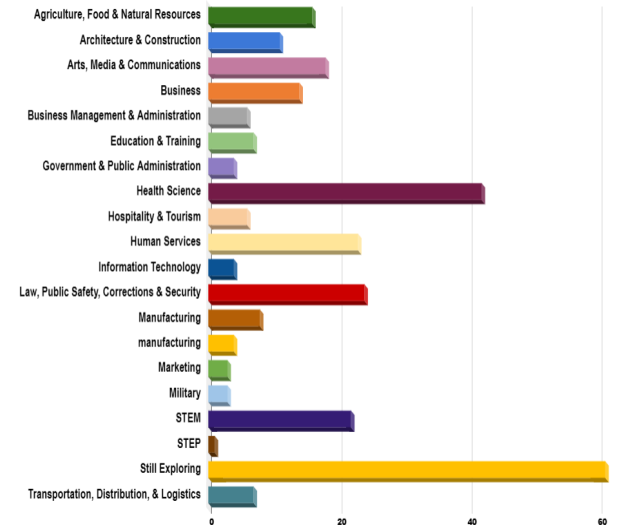
HIGHLIGHTS

Becoming a Partner in My Education Lesson

In this interactive lesson, students learn how to find, read, and interpret transcript and graduation status information in AERIES.
