Administrative Procedures for Policy #1740.7 (Administration) of the Board of Education Regarding Ethics: Private Tutoring and Private Educational Services

- I. Guidelines
 - A. The Board of Education acknowledges that there are times when a student may benefit from instruction or educational services beyond the regular school day. In fact, Calvert County Public Schools offers a variety of extra- and co-curricular activities and opportunities, and educational services designed to extend learning and/or offer reteaching and support. This support offered to individual students or a group of students before, during and after the school day is offered at no cost to student(s) and/or parent(s). In addition, CCPS occasionally offers extended learning and educational services through outside organizations for a modest fee.
- II. Definitions
 - A. <u>Private Educational Service Provider</u> Any service related to the educational program of a student or group of students performed for compensation by a person or entity other than the Calvert County Public Schools.
 - B. <u>Private Entity</u> A business, whether for profit or nonprofit, or an individual, including parents or guardians of students of the Calvert County Public Schools.
 - C. <u>Private Tutoring</u> Any instruction performed for compensation by a person or entity other than the Calvert County Public Schools.
- III. Possible conflicts of interest may arise when a Calvert County Public Schools employee contracts with a private entity to provide tutoring or educational services to a student(s) of Calvert County Public Schools. In order to avoid those conflicts, Calvert County Public Schools employees may not:
 - A. Privately tutor or offer private educational services to students for whom they are a teacher of record, related service provider or are serving in the course of regularly assigned duties;
 - B. Use Calvert County Public Schools' facilities, instructional materials, or equipment for private tutoring or for offering private educational services unless arrangements are made in advance through CCPS Policy #8120 – Use of School Facilities;
 - C. Privately tutor or offer private educational services to students during the contracted workday; or
 - D. Use time during the contracted workday or use Calvert County Public Schools resources to advertise private tutoring or private educational services.
- IV. Private tutors or private educational service providers who are self-employed or are employed by an entity other than the Calvert County Public Schools may not use Calvert County Public

V. The Superintendent or his/her designee may make exceptions to this procedure. Any exception must be made in writing.

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
