

Anna L. Klein Student Dress Code Guidelines

General Rules:

- Clothes must always fit appropriately.
- No undergarments should be visible at any time.
- Students that do not follow the uniform policy, will be subject to the School's Code of Conduct.
- School uniform shirts must always be worn (guidelines outlined below).
- If a student chooses to wear a mask in school to stop the spread of germs and/or diseases, only medical masks will be permitted.

Shirts/Sweatshirts:

- **Navy-blue cotton blend uniform shirts are mandatory.** They must have the Guttenberg School District insignia, (available in short or long sleeve styles).
- **Gold** T-shirts with the Guttenberg School District insignia or approved ALK school spirit wear are permitted for physical education classes only.
- Shirts must fit appropriately and not be cut, tied, or altered.
- ALK uniform sweatshirts or ALK spirit wear sold **ONLY** by ALK school sponsored organizations are permitted.
- *No recreation, town, or other shirts may be worn, unless on approved dress-down days.*

Pants/Bottoms: Khakis or slacks, cargo pants, sweatpants, corduroy pants, jeans, yoga pants, leggings, skirts, and shorts (see specifics below).

Permitted Colors for Pants/Bottoms: Blue, Black, Gray, or Khaki

Only sweatpants may be worn for physical education class.

- No ripped or torn pants or bottoms of any kind.
- No translucent or excessively tight leggings and/or yoga pants.
- No leggings and/or yoga pants may be worn with written words, images or designs imprinted on or across the garment.
- No skirts above the mid-thigh.
- Shorts may only be worn in September, May, and June; Shorts may be no shorter than mid-thigh.
- Tights may be worn underneath skirts in cold weather and may be blue, black, gray, or khaki, or beige.

Footwear: Sneakers, dress shoes, other closed-toe shoes, and/or boots are permitted in any color.

All shoes must be closed toed. All shoes **MUST** be securely fastened.

- All shoes must have a closed back.
- No flip flops, Crocs, slides, or UGG clogs of any type.

Headwear:

- Students may **NOT** wear or carry hats, hoods, sweatbands, bandanas, and/or sunglasses while in the school building.
- Head scarves and /or head coverings are permitted for religious or medical purposes only.
